

# Mr. K. Venkataramanan honoured as IPMA Level 'A' assessor in Project Management

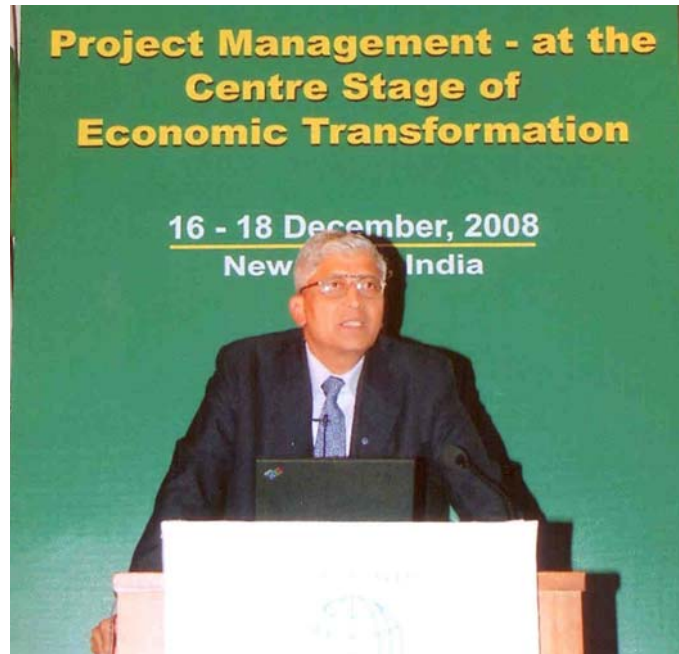
For his exemplary contribution to the improvement of project management practices, Mr. K. Venkataramanan, President (E&C Projects) and Member of the Board, L&T, was honoured with the title of IPMA Level 'A' assessor. He is the second Indian to receive this title.

International Project Management Associations (IPMA), Switzerland, is a global federal organization comprising more than 44 national representative bodies from over 42 countries across Europe, Africa, Asia and America.

IPMA provides project management guidelines, and has developed globally recognized 4 Level Certification (4LC) in project management. This is categorized as Level 'D' (lowest) to Level 'A' (highest). Project Management Associates (PMA) is the only organization authorized to conduct the IPMA 4 Level certification exam in India and award certificates.

The IPMA title was conferred upon Mr. Venkataramanan at the 16<sup>th</sup> Global Symposium on "Project Management – At the Centrestage of Economic Transformation" organized at Delhi from December 16-18<sup>th</sup>, 2008 by IPMA & International Construction Project Management Association in association with PMA & Centre for Excellence in Project Management.

Mr. Venkataramanan also delivered the keynote address at the concluding session on "Global Risk Management Practices for Large EPC Projects".
