### **Jeet Bindra Appointed to L&T Board as Independent non-executive Director**

**Mumbai Jan. 29:** Larsen & Toubro has appointed Jagjeet (“Jeet”) S. Bindra, president of Chevron Global Manufacturing, to its Board of Directors as an independent, non-executive director. Mr. Bindra has extensive executive experience with large international organizations in the USA, Australia and India.

Bindra leads Chevron’s worldwide manufacturing operations, overseeing approximately 10,000 employees and 20 refineries worldwide that together produce over 2.2 million barrels of crude per day.

Bindra joined Chevron in 1977 as a research engineer and over the next 31 years moved up to many leadership positions within Chevron, including president of Chevron Pipe Line Co. and managing director and CEO of Caltex Australia. In 2004, Bindra was named president of Global Refining, which in January 2008 was changed to Global Manufacturing.

Among the many successes of his 30-year career at Chevron, Bindra led an initiative to negotiate financing, design, and for construction of a critical pipeline to move crude from the Tengiz field in Kazakhstan to the Black Sea. He was the founding chairman of the board of the South Asian American Leaders of Tomorrow (SAALT), past vice chairman of the Association of Oil Pipe Lines, and served on the boards of Caltex Australia Limited, Reliance Petroleum Limited (India), and GS Caltex (South Korea).

In 2008, Bindra received the prestigious Diamond Award from the University of Washington (UW) College of Engineering’s in recognition of his career achievements. Bindra was named Distinguished Alumnus of the Indian Institute of Technology, Kanpur in 2000. Bindra is also a Distinguished Honorary Professor at the Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Petroleum Technology (RGIPT), at Jais, Dist. Rae Bareli.

An Indian by birth, Bindra received his bachelor's degree in chemical engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology in Kanpur in 1969 and a master's degree in chemical engineering from the University of Washington at Seattle in 1970. He earned a master's degree in business administration with honors from St. Mary's College in Moraga, California in 1979.
